PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT MEETING

RECONSTRUCTION OF BOBOLINK ROAD BRIDGE OVER CANADIAN PACIFIC RAILROAD TOWN OF LOWELL

The reconstruction of the Bobolink Road Bridge over the Canadian Pacific Railroad will be discussed at a public involvement meeting scheduled by the Town of Lowell in Dodge County, Wisconsin.

The meeting will be held on Thursday, December 5, 2019 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Town of Lowell Town Hall located at W8906 W. O'Sixteen Road, Reeseville, WI 53579.

The town and county are considering alternatives to remove or replace the existing bridge and reconstruct the roadway approaches on Bobolink Road over the Canadian Pacific Railroad located in Section 33 in the Town of Lowell, Dodge County, Wisconsin. Work could consist of bridge removal and replacement, grading, concrete masonry, crushed aggregate base course, asphalt pavement, erosion control items, and landscaping items.

During construction, Bobolink Road will be closed to traffic. Access to residences will be maintained at all times.

Work is scheduled to take place in the summer of 2021.

The purpose of the meeting is to present the preliminary alternatives of the work scheduled for the bridge construction project, discuss the proposed schedule, and gather public input. Any comments that may be of interest to the design team are welcome.

The meeting will be organized in an open-house format and interested persons are invited to stop by at their convenience. There will be a short presentation at the onset to provide an overview of the project. Representatives from the Town of Lowell, Dodge County and Ayres Associates will be available to discuss the design details, address comments, and answer questions. Displays showing the proposed project will be available for viewing.

Persons with a concern or knowledge about historic buildings and structures, public lands, and archaeological sites are encouraged to attend this meeting or provide comments to the Town of Lowell.
